**Sensitization of students and employees of the Institution to the constitutional obligations: values, rights, duties and responsibilities of citizens (within 500 words).**

We at St. Mary's Group of institutions Guntur believe in providing students with a comprehensive education. And among the fundamental teaching provided at the institute through a variety of techniques is sensitizing pupils to our constitutional rights, values, duties, and responsibilities.

Curriculum and extracurricular activities are used to make students and staff members of the institution aware of their constitutional duties. Many of the courses are designed to make students aware of their constitutional obligations. For instance, one Institute level elective course is focused on cyber security. Students learn about a variety of topics in this course, including cybercrime, cyberspace, the Indian IT Act, and more. Students in the Printing & Packaging Technology Program learn all the packaging laws and regulations established by Regulatory Bodies in one core curriculum called Laws, Regulations, and Sustainable Packaging. Additionally, all first-year students take a course on environmental studies that provides them with knowledge of environmental laws, the wildlife protection act, the forest act, and general environmental problems.

In addition to this, the ICC cell of the institute runs a number of regular activities to inform women about their rights. On days of national significance, seminars and workshops on various citizen rights, duties, and obligations are also held. Additionally, former defense or law enforcement officers are asked each year to impart their knowledge and educate and motivate young people to help improve the country. Periodically, seminars are held on subjects including sexual harassment and the right to information. Different sections and categories of the legislation are explained in the right to information seminar.

All college students are invited to participate in the Model United Nations (MUN) program, which is a two-day conference on international relations organized by the institute. Topics covered include nuclear disarmament, preventing potential human rights violations brought about by advances in networking and communication technology, increasing employment opportunities for refugees and internally displaced people (DPs), and enacting a uniform civil code throughout the nation.

To commemorate Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, the institution's NSS section organizes a cleaning campaign on the college campus as well as in the adjacent hamlet. All faculty members and students swear to maintain a clean environment. Additionally, numerous skits and dance acts are presented at numerous sensitization-related occasions. Corrupt practices, youth responsibility, child labor, the detrimental effects of society on our passions and dreams, social media abuse, favoritism, mental health, and other issues are just a few of the subjects tackled.
